

Many people are cared for at home. The people providing care (spouses, daughters, sons, grandchildren, partners, special friends, even you) are often in need of **respite care**. The Fulton Co. Office for Aging offers a few choices of respite for all generations:

▶ In-Home Care: is provided through contracts that the Fulton Co. Office for Aging has with local licensed home care agencies. The staff at Central Assessment/NYConnects Fulton County completes assessments for this service. The results are plans of care where an aide would go to a person's home to give the caregiver a break. Call 518-736-5718.

- ➤ Social Adult Day Care: is also offered as a choice for respite for those individuals who choose non-institutional services outside the home. Central Assessment/NYConnects evaluates for this service. Care is provided at the Johnstown Senior Center through a contract with the Fulton Co. Office for Aging, M-F, 9am-2:30pm. Transportation is provided. Donations accepted. Call 518-736-5718.
- ▼ Activity Days: at the Fulton County YMCA offer respite for grandparents raising grandchildren and other kincaregivers. The Fulton Co. Office for Aging contracts with the YMCA for vacation camps and YMCA services for the grandchildren and other kin so that the caregivers get a break. Call 518-736-5650
